### **DESCRIPTION OF BASIC RESPONSIBILITIES**

To perform general and varied grounds maintenance and gardening functions including a variety of unskilled and semi-skilled labor and repair work.

**SUPERVISOR:** Director of Maintenance & Operations

## **TYPICAL DUTIES**

- 1. Prunes, waters, and sprays trees, shrubs, hedges, and plants.
- 2. Mows lawn areas with power mower and edges around walks and shrub areas.
- 3. Weeds and cleans around shrub areas and trees.
- 4. Uses hand tools to work soil and to remove weeds, undergrowth, and debris from school grounds and landscaped areas.
- 5. Cleans out water drainage in yards and cleans gutters on buildings.
- 6. Rakes leaves and hauls to dump.
- 7. Plants flowers, trees, and reseeds lawns.
- 8. Builds wooden frames around trees, lawns, and shrubs.
- 9. Sprays weeds in parking lots and along fences.
- 10. Applies pesticides and herbicides to grounds and garden areas for pest/weed control purposes.
- 11. Installs, maintains, and repairs sprinklers and sprinkler systems.
- 12. Safely operates and performs minor service and routine maintenance repair to a variety of related hand and power tools including mowers, sweepers, edgers, sprayers.
- 13. Drives pickup truck with appropriate tools, equipment, and materials for assigned projects at designated sites.
- 14. Establishes schedule of groundskeeping landscaping plans and activities with Principals and Supervisor.
- 15. Monitors and responds to District radio communication network.
- 16. Performs other duties similar to the above in scope and function as required.

# **EMPLOYMENT STANDARDS**

Possession of a valid California Driver's License.

#### **Knowledge of:**

- proper groundskeeping and gardening methods and practices;
- safe use and application of pesticides and herbicides for pest/weed control purposes;
- safe use and operation of a variety of tools and equipment used in gardening, repair and grounds maintenance repair work.

### **Ability to:**

- understand and follow both oral and written instructions in an independent manner;
- read and write at a level necessary to perform the duties of the position;
- use and operate a variety of hand tools, power tools, and equipment in a safe and proper manner:
- drive pickup truck safely;
- read and interpret landscaping plans;
- perform basic mathematical calculations including addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division;
- estimate the scope of work assignments including necessary tools and materials to complete each assignment;
- meet the physical requirements necessary to safely and effectively perform required duties;
- communicate effectively in both oral and written forms;
- establish and maintain effective work relationships with those contacted in the performance of required duties.

# TYPICAL WORKING CONDITIONS AND ENVIRONMENT

- 1. Regularly performs heavy physical labor requiring ability to lift, carry, push, pull and move heavy objects or materials.
- 2. Work both inside and outside in a variety of temperatures and weather conditions.
