JOB TITLE: Instructional Assistant/Bilingual

#### DESCRIPTION OF BASIC RESPONSIBILITIES

To assist a Teacher in the instruction, supervision, and training of individual or groups of bilingual students by performing a variety of instructional support activities related to an effective learning environment.

SUPERVISOR: Principal

#### TYPICAL DUTIES

- 1. To assist teachers with instruction to individuals or groups of students in reading, writing, and speaking English as a second language and assists bilingual students in other academic subject areas.
- 2. Interprets for limited English speaking students in a regular classroom by translating assignments, explanations, or instructions.
- 3. Uses flashcards, games, worksheets, drills, and a variety of study aids and techniques.
- 4. Administers a variety of tests and quizzes, records results, and consults with teacher regarding student progress.
- 5. Organizes work areas and assembles learning materials.
- 6. May order classroom related supplies, forms, instructional, or audiovisual materials.
- 7. Observes, assesses, and records each students learning experiences, activities, and progress.
- 8. Supervises students to maintain an effective learning environment, disciplining as necessary.
- 9. Performs clerical duties specifically related to classroom instruction as assigned.
- 10. Prepares specialized learning materials and instructional aids according to direction and specification.
- 11. Performs other duties similar to the above in scope and function as required.

- Proper English usage, vocabulary, and grammar.

## Ability to:

- Understand and carry out both oral and written instructions in an independent manner;

- Understand the needs of non-English speaking and/or bilingual children and to effectively relate to those needs in an appropriate learning situation;
- Establish and maintain effective work relationships with those contacted in the performance of required duties.
