Why Attendance in SchoolPreparing Our Students forMatters?Success - Measure H Facility Bond

Students that miss an average of 1-2 days of school a month can be at risk of not meeting grade level standards and not graduating from high school. In the earlier years of school, poor attendance can influence whether children read proficiently by the end of third grade. By 6th grade, poor attendance becomes a leading indicator that a student will drop out of high school.

All of our schools have social workers or counselors to support families. Please schedule a meeting with school staff if your child is struggling with attendance. Staff will be reaching out to families to schedule an attendance meeting when there becomes a pattern of missing school.
