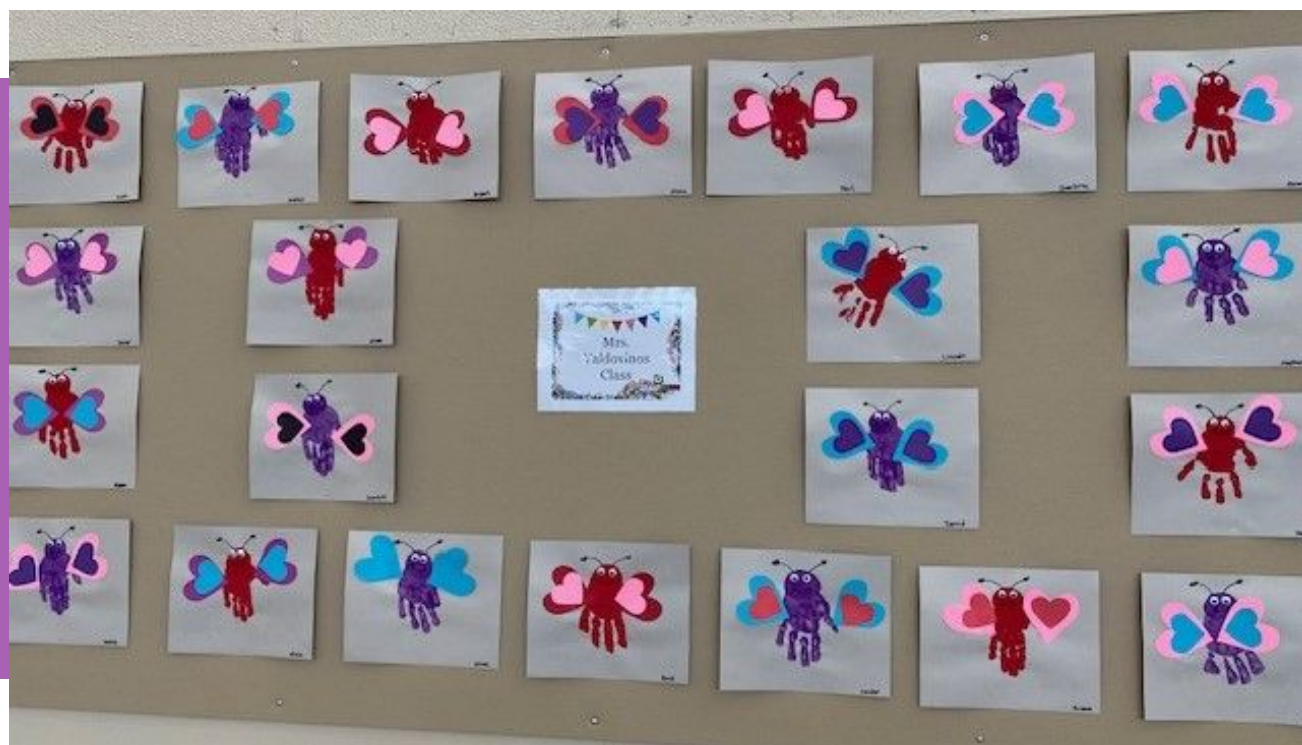
- Expanded Learning Program - June 14th-July 24th from 7:30-4:30. No program on June 19th and July 4th.
