Please come out to support the District's music program at this annual event.

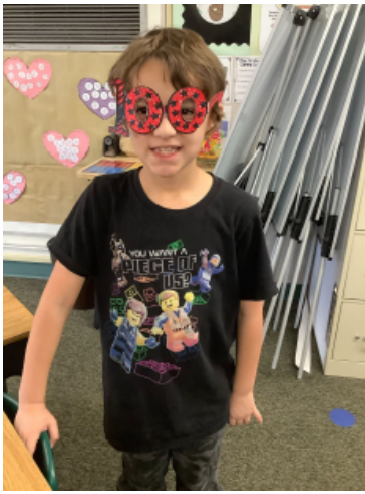
