

 - Map is attached to this addendum, portables are shaded and consist of:
 - i. Rooms 1 & 2: Metal portables, exterior paint only.
 - ii. Rooms 15, 16, 17, 18, 22, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 30, 32 and the pre-school office, dry rot repair where needed and exterior paint.

- 6. Can you please identify the required dry rot damage for each portable building?
 - Dry rot was discussed during the job walk, each participant should use professional judgement on the extent of the needed repair to each.
- 7. What is extent of the dry rot repair? Do we need to replace the entire T1-11 / skirting panel, fascia section, etc.?
 - Dry rot was discussed during the job walk, each participant should use professional judgement on the extent of the needed repair to each. The minimum height of T1-11 replacement would be 2 feet.
- 8. Do we need to replace all gutters and downspouts for 15 portables?
 - Gutter/downspouts are as needed, where gutter/downspout needs replacement or is missing.
- 9. Can you please provide any specification for the new gutters and downspouts?
 - Galvanized gutters and downspouts
- 10. Who is responsible for removing any conduits during the dry rot repair?
 - Contractor's responsibility
- 11. Who is responsible for removing any HVAC units (if needed) during the dry rot repair?
 - HVAC units are to not be removed, repair will occur around the units.
- 12. Are the paint colors going to match existing, similar or away different colors?
 - The District has the Kelly Moore paint colors to provide contractor that match existing paint colors.
- 13. Are there plans available?
 - There are no plans for this specific project.
- 14. Is the DVBE a requirement?
 - Yes, if you are using sub-contractors the attempt should be made due to the funding source paying for this project.
- 15. Is there an Asbestos, Lead Abatement Project Specification? If applicable.
