Back to School Night and Principals' Message

Please plan on attending Back to School Night to learn important school information from your school's principal and your child's teacher. These dates and times are located on your school's website.

ParentVUE - Synergy - Student Information System

The District is electronic for the parent information guide and the various forms parents are required to complete at the start of the school year. When you log into ParentVUE, you will be prompted to update your student's information and complete the required forms. You will not be able to access the other components of ParentVUE until these steps are completed. **For access to ParentVUE, visit your child's school office for your unique login.** Once you use this login to create your account, you will have access to ParentVUE as long as your child is enrolled in the District and your login information remains the same each school year.

Student Transportation

To apply for transportation to and from school, please fill out the Transportation Application on the <u>Transportation Website</u>. You can also pick up the application at any school site or the district office. Once completed, the form can be sent to the transportation department email at transportation@galt.k12.ca.us or dropped off in person at the transportation trailer at 1019 Beaver Park Way or your school office.
