## Chat Box Questions from the Feb. 1st DLI Information Meeting

- 1. Is the DLI program only going to be offered at the Fairsite and Valley Oaks Campuses? Yes, the program will initially begin at the preschool and TK grades at Fairsite and then expand to Valley Oaks for Kinder in 2023-24
- 2. If my student attends Lake Canyon would I be able to transfer them to Valley Oaks for this program specifically? Yes. The program is open to all families who reside in Galt.
- 3. Is there a target academic year that the program will begin? *It will begin in preschool and TK in 2022.* Will it continue at middle school? Yes...*it will grow by one grade level each year and reach middle school be 2030*
- 4. So far, advantages of DLI have been provided. What are the possible disadvantages? One disadvantage for families is that it will be offered only at one school and students may need to move schools to participate.
- 5. How easy is it to transfer schools in order to participate in this program? *Very easy...DLI* registration will be on a first come first serve basis.
- 6. How many students will you be starting the program with? *We will begin with two classrooms with a maximum of 22 students in each classroom (50% native Spanish & 50% native English)*
- 7. What are the hours of the Preschool and TK classes? *They will be ½ day with A.M. and P.M. classes*
- 8. Would older siblings be able to transfer schools if the younger sibling is accepted into the program? *Parents would need to complete a School of Choice for older students. Priority is given to students who already have siblings at the school.*
- 9. Will there be transportation? We are planning for transportation services at the TK level at Fairsite...but parents will need to transport their students to Valley Oaks
- 10. Will the registration happen online or in person? *Students must <u>first enroll in the School</u> <u>District</u> (<i>TK registration is online, downloadable or a paper version is available at all schools*) The <u>DLI Application</u> will be available to download from our website or a paper version will be available at Fairsite or Valley Okkas.
- 11. When will enrollment open? *DLI Applications will be available March 1st*.
- 12. Will there be an enrollment lottery or how will students be chosen in order to attend if space is limited? *We will date stamp each registration and also select by lottery if needed.*

- 13. After tonight, if we were in this meeting we will be receiving a packet of info and then notification about open Registration/enrollment starting March 1? *We will be contacting all families who complete the DLI interest form. We also will send out a district-wide email notifying families.*
- 14. If we don't intend to continue the program long term, are there still benefits to having them in for just a year or two? *Parents are encouraged to commit to enrollment in the DLI program from TK-6 grade. A student will not reach fluency in Spanish if only in DLI for only 1-2 years.*
- 15. Will the bilingual teachers be moving with the student as they move grades, similar to a cohort model? *There will be 2 credentialed bilingual teachers for each grade level*. Does this implicate more hires or more professional development for current teachers? *We currently have enough bilingual credentialed teachers…but in the next 4 years we do anticipate new hires will be needed. Professional Development and training will be ongoing.*
- 16. What happens if students in the program leave over the years, how will those student positions in the program be filled? We do expert there to be some attrition...we will continue to fill the English openings at Kinder and possibly first grade. Fluent Spanish speakers may join at any grade level.
- 17. Can inter-district students participate? Yes, but only if there are additional openings
- 18. Will the children get one teacher for the Spanish part of the day and another teacher for the English part? *Students will remain with their bilingual teacher for most of the day.*
- 19. You mentioned offering a beginning Spanish class? Yes, *Fairsite will offer a beginning Spanish class for parents.*
- 20. Will there be a principal and VP assigned specifically to this program? *No, the site administrators at both schools will be directing the program. Support will also be provided from the district level.*
- 21. As the program grows, will it catch up to upper grade levels. For example I have kinder and second graders.... will they be able to participate at some point? *Unfortunately, no. It will be starting at the TK level and growing one grade level per year*
- 22. Since the Dual Language Immersion Program will not be available in all schools and grades, is there a plan to at least start offering Spanish as an additional subject? *This would be an exciting new opportunity for students at our other schools…perhaps as an enrichment class or afterschool. We plan to offer Spanish as a foreign language at McCaffrey Middle SChool beginning next year.*

- 23. You mentioned a Spanish teacher that may offer to teach Spanish as a second language, how soon could this happen? Or is there a program in the area that can help teach after school? *It will depend on bilingual teachers at the other schools and with sufficient interest, it could be offered after school.*
- 24. I'm not able to enroll my current kindergartener and first grader? *Unfortunately, no. We are beginning the program at the preschool and TK level.*
- 25. If I have a daughter at Greer..... can I enroll my son at Valley Oaks? Or would I have to put both students at Valley oaks? *No, you have the option of having your students at both schools*
- 26. Will Valley Oak campus be modified to accommodate the program, the school seems small? Valley Oaks has ample classroom space to accommodate the DLI program.
- 27. Is there a program lead teacher or have there been talks to find a program lead? *The bilingual teachers will form a team to work together under site leadership.*
- 28. How long do you anticipate expanding this program to other elementary schools in Galt? After our first school is launched successfully, it would depend on community interest, waiting lists and bilingual teachers.
- 29. Can my son go to preschool if he turns 3 March 28th? Yes, Fairsite preschool accepts 3 and 4 year olds.
  - a. Priority enrollment goes to children who turn 4 between February 2-September 1 (Children who turn 4 years old before Feb 2 are eligible for TK)
  - b. Children must turn 3 by Sept. 1st to be eligible for preschool.
  - c. Enrollment in the State Preschool is based on family income. However, <u>there will</u> <u>not be an income requirement for children enrolled in the DLI classes.</u>
