Dual Language Immersion

Students will learn the foundations of a dual language. They will have the opportunity to be bilingual and bi-literate and become academically successful in both English and Spanish.

- Students will acquire a starting level of literacy in Spanish to be better prepared to transfer over to the K-8 Dual Language Immersion Academy.
- Students will develop an appreciation of other cultures.
- Students will be provided with a rich environment that supports dual language learning by tying language through the preschool learning domains and intentional teaching strategies.

Full Inclusion Practices

Inclusive education is a system in which students with special needs can attend school with their typically developing peers. An inclusive preschool system integrates special education and related services into all aspects of its program. This makes it possible to address the needs of both special needs and typically developing children.

Academic Parent Teacher Teams (APTT)

APPT is a model of family engagement that is grounded in the belief that schools can thrive when families and teachers work together, as genuine partners, to maximize student learning inside and outside of school. APTT elevates the efforts of traditional parent conferences by expanding opportunities for families and teachers to collaborate.



Universal Transitional Kindergarten (TK) for 4 Year Olds

Assembly Bill 130 established an early learning initiative to expand access to classroom-based prekindergarten programs offered by school districts and will ensure clearly articulated Preschool to Grade 3 (P-3) early education programs. A comprehensive TK program includes partnerships for inclusive practices, multi-lingual learning, and differentiated instruction.

TK eligibility: Will expand to include children who have their 4th birthday by September 1st of the current school year.

- 2023-24: Turn 5 between Sept. 2, 2023 - April 2, 2024
- 2024-25: Turn 5 between Sept. 2, 2024 - June 2, 2025
- 2025-26: Turn 5 between Sept. 2, 2025 - Sept. 1, 2026
