As we wrap up the 2023-24 school year, there's some important information to share with you. First, I want to thank our parents and guardians for supporting our staff and providing feedback throughout the year. Based on your feedback, we continue to improve our efforts in educating your children. By working together, schools and families can create a supportive and enriching environment that fosters the academic and personal growth of every student.

Synergy - Student Information System

Next school year, the District will be electronic for the parent information guide and the various forms parents are required to complete at the start of the school year. Beginning in August, when you log into Synergy you will be prompted to update your student's information and complete required forms. You will not be able to access the other components of Synergy until these steps are completed. **For access to Synergy, call or visit your child's school office. On Tuesday, June 18th the school offices will be closing for the summer. Offices will reopen for the 2024-25 school year on Thursday, July 25th.**

State Assessment Scores in Synergy

The California Department of Education has developed an electronic process for each school district to share student scores for SBAC, ELPAC, and CAST. All *State Assessment Student Score Reports* are available electronically through the ParentVUE portal of our Student Information System, Synergy.

All parents and guardians can access these reports by logging in to ParentVUE and clicking on the "State Tests" link on the left hand side of the dashboard, then clicking on "CAASPP" to view downloadable PDFs of the score reports. It is recommended to access the parent portal with a desktop, laptop or tablet for optimal viewing of these reports. Should you need assistance, please contact or visit your child's school office.

Local Control Accountability Plan (LCAP)

The District's LCAP outlines strategic goals and actions for continuous improvement. Specific actions have measurable outcomes and aligned fiscal resources. The LCAP is updated annually after feedback from multiple educational partners.
